The incoming President appointed Ken Waringa to serve on the BOD in the position given up by Robert Hart. (Sec. Note: This term will expire in 2008.)


It was decided to have the AOM, send a letter to CDR Anderjack to invite active duty members to serve as regional representatives of their area.






